

Hazard Reporting Procedures

Legislation states that employers are required to ensure that all employees have a safe work environment.

To this end, Modular Solutions welcomes all employees to report any type of hazard or potential hazard directly to their branch office, the Health and Safety Manager or to their supervisor at the client location where they are working.

Whenever possible, Modular Solutions shall conduct an investigation of the hazard with the client or our branch (whichever is applicable). Modular Solutions shall attempt to ensure that every reasonable precaution is taken for the protection of the worker while at the client's location.

In the event that employees feel that they cannot continue to perform their regular duties without chance of injury, they are required to immediately report the problem to their supervisor. If for any reason the supervisor does not rectify the problem they are required to immediately contact the branch office.

The branch office shall attempt to resolve the issue with the client and will call the Modular Solutions Health and Safety Manager for further direction.
